By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts **instantly**.

They should be able to answer these questions in any order, including missing number questions,

e.g.
$$10 \times \bigcirc = 30 \text{ or } \bigcirc \times 3 = 12.$$

Top Tips

The secret to success is practising **little** and **often**. Use time wisely. Can you practise these KIRFs while walking to school or during a car journey? You don't need to practise them all at once: perhaps you could have a fact of the day.

<u>Times Table Rockstars – Children all have their username and password to practice in the "Garage" and the "Arena".</u> They could try playing in the "Studio" but remember these will be any questions up to 12x12.

<u>Songs and Chants</u> – You can buy Times Tables CDs or find multiplication songs and chants online. If your child creates their own song, this can make the times tables even more memorable.
